This letter is in regard to your February 11, 2016 petition to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for reconsideration of the 40 CFR 80.1406, finalized in "Regulation of Fuels and Fuel Additives: Renewable Fuel Standards," 75 FR 14670, March 26, 2010. In your petition you requested reconsideration of the definition of an "obligated party" in the Renewable Fuel Standard program.

This letter is to notify you of the EPA's proposed denial of your petition as well as others seeking similar EPA action, as described in the enclosed Proposed Denials of Petitions to Change the Point of Obligation."
